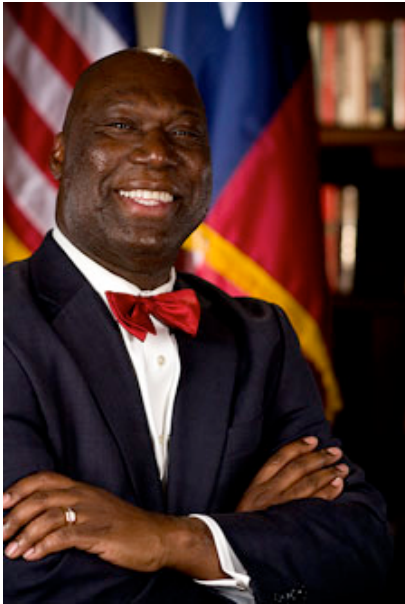

Contributions are not tax deductible for federal income tax purposes. Individuals may contribute a maximum of \$4,800 - \$2,400 undesignated to be used for the next subsequent election and an additional \$2,400 designated for a runoff. Multi-candidate PACs may give a maximum of \$10,000 - \$5,000 for the next subsequent election and \$5,000 designated for a runoff. Contributions to Michael Williams for U.S. Senate Committee are subject to the prohibitions and limitations of the Federal Election Campaign Act. That law prohibits federal contributions from corporations, labor unions, and foreign nationals who are not admitted for permanent residence. All contributions must be made from personal funds and may not be reimbursed by any other person. Contributions are not tax deductible for federal income tax purposes.
